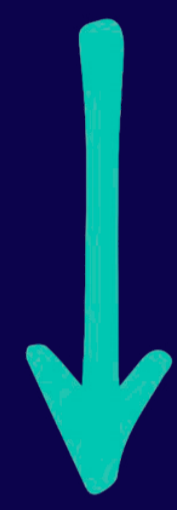


UGANDA'S NCD FINANCING LANDSCAPE

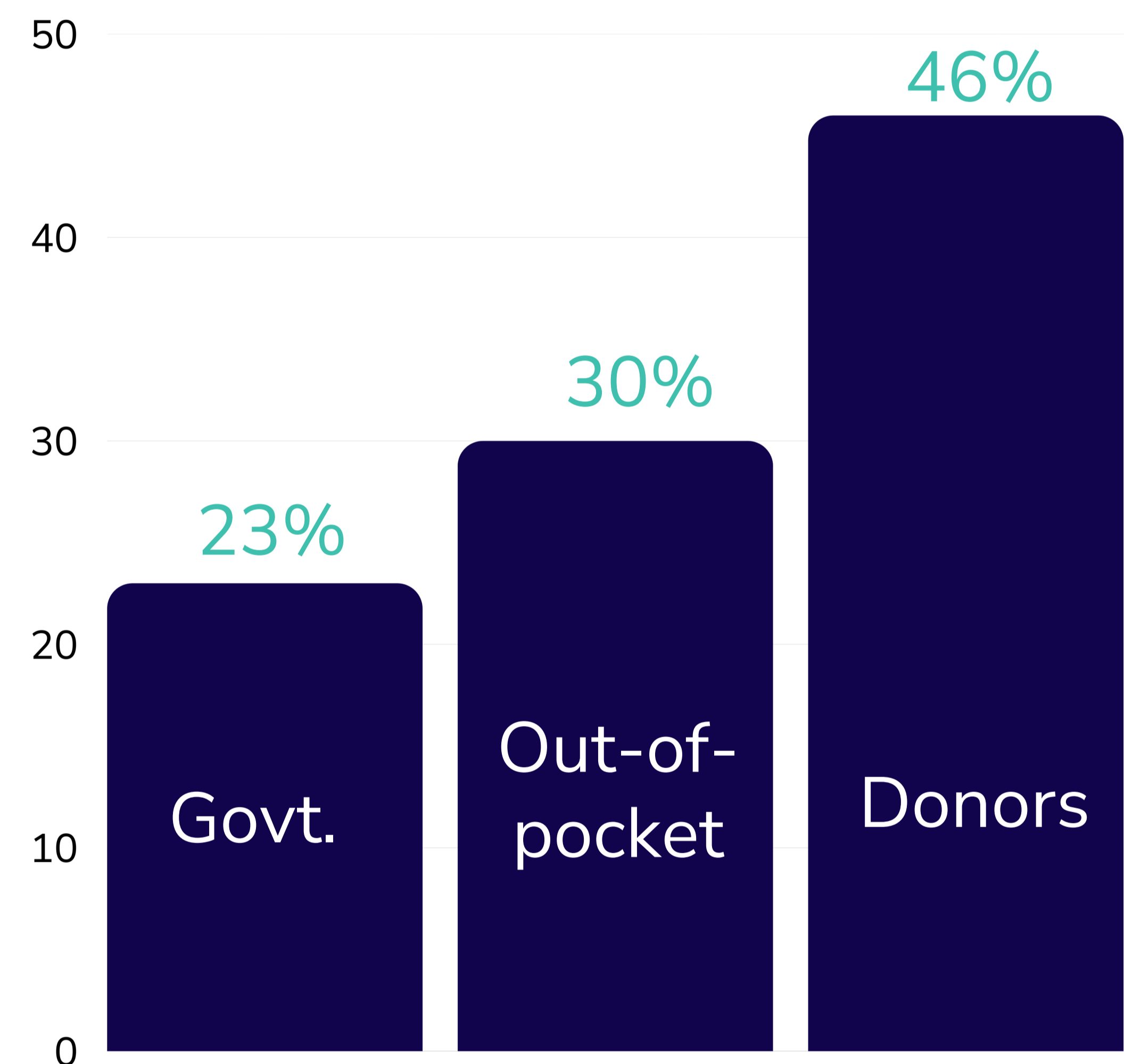
Non-wage recurrent NCD funds spent by mid-FY2024/25, revealing absorption and disbursement challenges.

Data Gaps



Uganda tracks health financing via National Health Accounts and Health Management Information System but faces major NCD data gaps, including poor disaggregation, fragmented reporting, and no real-time monitoring.
